#### Areas of focus

- 1) Locating electronic books as one-to-one replacements of existing course textbooks with no cost to students.
- 2) Hosting print copies of textbooks on Reserve.
- 3) Identifying open educational resources (OER) and library-sourced information as alternatives to commercially produced textbooks.
- 4) Tracking metrics associated with faculty adoptions.
