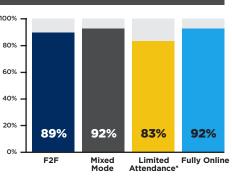

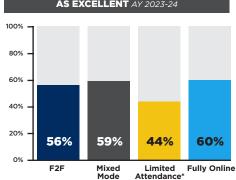

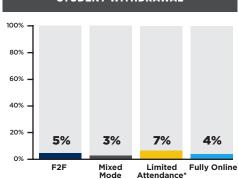
STUDENT SUCCESS (A, B, OR C GRADE)

WHAT IS A SUCCESS COACH?

A Success Coach develops relationships with UCF Online students to help them set and achieve academic goals, from inquiry to graduation. Coaches and students work together to:

- Establish educational objectives
- Co-create strategies to stay on track to graduation
- Co-develop academic plans that align with career goals
- Connect to appropriate resources for program specific support

RITE

At the heart of the Division of Digital Learning's mission is a commitment to advancing teaching and learning through evidence-based practices. The Research Initiative for Teaching Effectiveness (RITE) conducts empirical research to assess the impact of digital learning modalities and applications on students and faculty.

These longitudinal studies examine the effectiveness of distance learning and technology integration in higher education, providing faculty and administrators with evidence-based recommendations, and ultimately supporting UCF's commitment to pedagogical excellence and student success.

DIGITAL CURRICULUM INNOVATION

INTELLIGENT COURSE SEARCH

Developed by CDL's Learning Systems & Technology Team, RITE is capturing feedback from student and faculty users each semester to help with the tool design and improvements.

Working with instructional designers and others to capture data from faculty and student users. Also capturing analytics to examine how student engagement with this discussion tool can help them better succeed in their courses.

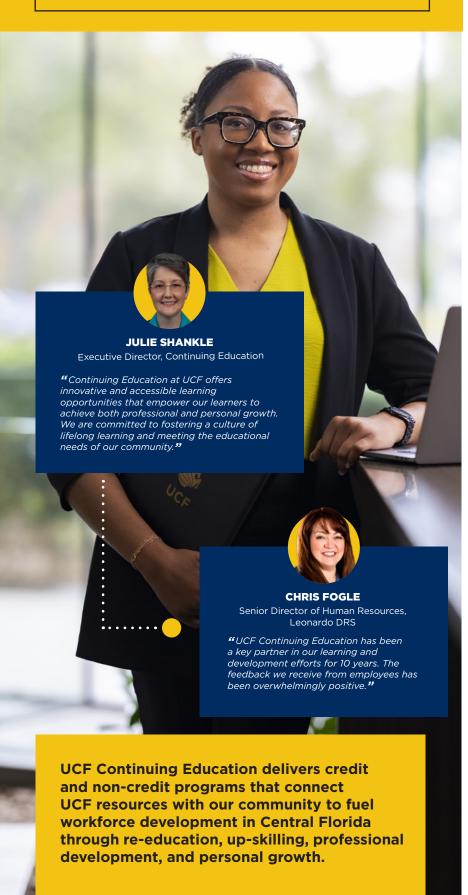
